Your child's zoned campus based on your home address is Annie Webb Blanton Elementary. Blanton was selected to be an Accelerating Campus Excellence (ACE) school last spring in order to provide additional needed support and improve student achievement. Parents/guardians of students at the ACE campuses were given the option to "opt-out" of their ACE campus and instead attend an alternate campus with available space in the 2015-16 school year. You submitted a pledge indicating that your child is opting out of Blanton.
